## WEED OUT THE WORRY

*Matthew 6:31* Therefore, do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?

We can see here the connection between worry and the words we speak. Worrying causes us to be preoccupied with things that cause anxiety and stress.
